We're Reflex Theatre, a local theatre company and we have an amazing opportunity for your child.

In the Easter, we partnered up with The Fisher Theatre, Bungay to deliver Kidsfest and we had such a blast. Now, for the summer holidays, we are back at the Fisher to bring you JumpStart: an amazing summer of drama and nutritional activities for children aged 8-14, supported with funds from Suffolk County Council's HAF programme.

For two weeks, starting from the 1st of August, your child can develop their theatre making skills, performance abilities, creativity and confidence with our professional theatre practitioners.
