Monday the 4th of July for Larch and Oak class.

Sports Day

Sports day will be taking place on **Friday 8th July 2022**. Please note that **Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** will be competing in the **morning** and **Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6** will be competing in the **afternoon**. Parents and family members are invited to come along and support their children at the following times:

10:15am and finish at 11.45am - Reception, Year 1 and 2 will have their competitions.

12:00pm - Children to be collected by parents for picnic lunch on school field. Collect children from the school hall, using the doors to the side playground. Teachers will take register and dismiss children for lunch. Collect Grab and Go lunch if ordered from the kitchen. Remaining children are to be supervised by school staff.

1.00pm - Whistle will be blown on the field and all children return to classes to be registered.

1:15pm and finish at 14:50pm - Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 pupils will have their competitions.

3.00pm - (KS1 and KS2) End of sports day and award ceremony. Parents to leave field/site Children dismissed.

Although there will be some seating available, parents and family members are encouraged to bring camping chairs that can be set up in a designated area of the school field, to enjoy the field and track events that the children will be participating in.

During sports day, please note in the interest of safety:

- Parents / Toddlers please use the disabled toilets situated at the end of the corridor outside main hall doors only. Please do not use the children's toilets.
- If attending the picnic lunch, please take responsibility for the safety of your child / children once collected.

Throughout the week, please ensure:

- Your child/children have the correct school P.E. kit of **trainers, dark socks, dark shorts**, and a **Clare Community Primary School P.E. shirt**, in school, every day during this week. Children must also have a **full water bottle** for lessons / activities / sports day.
- Your child is well equipped with **sun cream and sun hat** and, in case of bad weather, **warm / waterproof clothing**.

We will send out an email to all parents, in advance as possible, if sports day needs to be cancelled due to bad weather.
