### Messages

#### Medication in school

If you feel you need to give your child Calpol before school please think carefully about whether they are well enough to last a day in school. For antibiotics and other medication please try to administer the doses at home. We understand that this can be difficult for our younger pupils who have earlier bedtimes and will, of course, accommodate for this when necessary. Office staff have daily medications that need to be administered for some pupils and therefore we ask that you think carefully about brining in any other medications to school that could be administered outside of school hours as some days this has added a considerable amount of work to office staff. We accommodate medication whenever we can, but just ask.

#### Clubs

As with last January, we have decided to prioritise lunchtime clubs this term while the weather is wet and cold. Therefore there will be no after school clubs this term. After school clubs will return in the summer term.

### One way system

I need to remind parents, carers and pupils again that there is a one way system in place in the playground to prevent pupils entering and exiting through the car park. This was put in during Covid but I am now considering locking the side gate again if we cannot adhere to the one way system. In the morning enter through the long path/main gate and exit via carpark (Ensuring younger siblings are kept off banks and prevented from running into the car park) afternoon the opposite, entering via carpark side gate and exiting via long path/main gate. Pupils should not be leaving the site via the side gate as this leads into the carpark where staff and visitors are leaving and could cause a serious accident. I will continue to monitor this week and hope to be able to keep both gates open. However, if safety is compromised we will no longer be using the side gate. Thank you for your cooperation.

The weather is forecast to be icy over the next few days with the possibility of some snow. This makes conditions in the playground difficult so we assess this each day and keep children in when there is a lot of ice. Please ensure children are not running and skidding in the playgrounds before and after school and that they stay off the top area until staff are present.

In the case of snow, if the school is due to close we will inform you of this as soon as possible. We often have to ascertain whether staff are able to safely attend and therefore decisions will not always be made straight away. If you have not been informed then please assume that the intention is to open. We will inform you via School Comms as soon as possible if we are closing. Please refrain from messaging staff in the mornings as decisions will be communicated to you as soon as a decision is made. 
