Messages

Uniform reminders

All pupils can now wear the summer uniform including the polo shirts in Key Stage 2 instead of shirts and ties.

A reminder that boots should **not** be worn to school. Our uniform policy has always stated that trainers and boots are not to be worn. I had let this go in the winter months due to the very cold weather. However, children have continued to wear these this term when they are not needed. Please can all pupils refrain from wearing boots to school. Shoes should be black. A plain sensible sandal may be worn with socks.

Hair

Hair that is past the shoulders should be tied up Matching, discrete accessories can be worn (No large/colourful headbands or accessories please - school colours are permitted)

Hair should not be dyed or bleached

No extreme hairstyles or shaved designs

Earrings—these should only be a small stud and these need to be removed or covered for PE. We have excessively large/colourful studs being worn. Please could they wear a small stud only.

Census Day Thursday 18th May

This Thursday is National School Census Day where we complete data about the number of children in school and whether they are having a school meal or not. We encourage as many of our pupils from Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as possible to have a school dinner (Hot or Cold) on this day. The figures we submit are used to calculate the money the school is given to fund our universal free school meals. This has a significant impact on our school budget, especially in these times when budgets are being increasingly squeezed. We will be serving our usual menu as below:

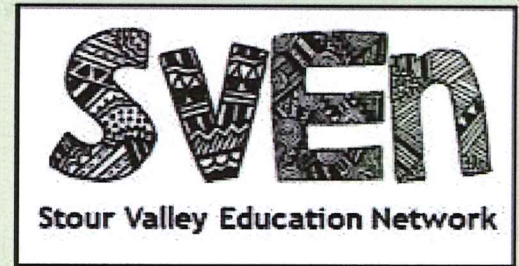
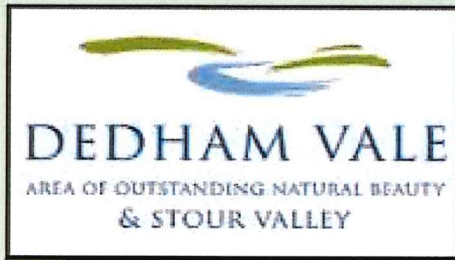
If your child already receives SCC funded travel you still need to opt in every year.
