

SPORT AND P.E. PREMIUM MONEY AT CLARE PRIMARY SCHOOL

As a school we are very fortunate to receive 'P.E. and Sport Premium Funding' to improve the sports provision at our school. Between September 2017 and August 2018 we will have received approximately £16,000. The amount of money has been doubled this year! This gives us a fantastic opportunity to grow and develop Clare Primary pupils' involvement and love of P.E. Last year it helped us receive the Bronze Sports Award, and this year we are keen to aim for Silver!

Our vision for PE is for more and more pupils to become involved in clubs and sports, including competitions. We want everyone to have the opportunity to experience the thrill of competing against other schools, not just the most able. It is

fantastic for our school to win events, but we would much rather pupils take part and develop confidence to play, than focus on winning.

Since September, we have taken part in a cross country race, sports hall athletics, table tennis, and we are currently top of the football league. Later on in the year, we hope to repeat last year's top performance at the local district sports.

Some of the money is being used to fund a new sports kit, complete with the Clare Primary School

badge, to raise the prestige of our teams and increase pride within our school. The school is particularly proud of our football team as last year they won the league cup and are off to a flying start this season. Thank you to all staff, pupils and parents for your hard work in making this happen!

This year, we have tried to offer an ever increasing number and variety of clubs for our pupils. Some money has already been spent on helping resource and fund Breakfast and Lunchtime clubs, provided through Dellar Sports Coaching. We are also offering the chance to take part in football, led by a professional coach, and we will be seeking further opportunities to widen the variety of sports on offer and get more pupils enjoying leisure activities.

During PE lessons, the sports premium is used to fund Teaching Assistant time for those pupils who need one to one support. We have also completed an inventory of the sports facilities at the school, and used some money to restock the PE cupboard.
